A visit to **Miserden Garden**, Gloucestershire **GL66 7JA** and **Painswick Rococo Garden**, Gloucestershire **GL6 6TH**



**Miserden** is a historic walled garden, established in the 17th century, overlooking a deer park and the Cotswold hills. Notable features include a topiary yew walk, distinctive grass steps by Sir Edwin Lutyens, and the Miserden Park house (built in 1620), which is not open to visitors but creates a scenic backdrop, especially when covered in spring wisteria. The garden's long mixed borders display roses, clematis, shrubs, and herbaceous plants for year-round colour. Highlights include a 200-year-old sycamore set into a stone wall, an ancient mulberry planted in 1620, a rill with a fountain, a stone summerhouse, and a spiral of dahlias.

**Painswick Rococo Garden**, the only fully intact Rococo garden in England, was designed in the 1740s by Benjamin Hyett as a theatrical retreat behind Painswick House. Set in a Cotswold valley, it includes playful buildings, winding paths, pools, follies, a kitchen garden, and woodland walks for relaxed exploration. Restored in the 1980s, it now showcases Georgian garden style—ornate, romantic, and distinctive.



### Timetable & Costs

The luxury coach departs Liphook Millennium Hall at **8.00 am**, St Christopher's Green at **8.15 am** and Haslemere Hall at **8.30 am**. Arriving at Miserden at **10.15 am**, a Tea Room serves seasonally locally sourced food and picturesque spots for picnics. We will have plenty of time to look around this beautiful garden before we leave for Painshill at **2.00 pm**, arriving at **2.30 pm**. The price per person is **£42.00 (NT Members)**, and **£59 (non-NT Members)**. There is a pantry for teas and locally made cakes, and snacks. Penhurst Place has a garden centre stocked with a range of plants found in the gardens. There will be plenty of room on the coach to bring plants home.
